**Discriminatory abuse can be because people see you differently.**



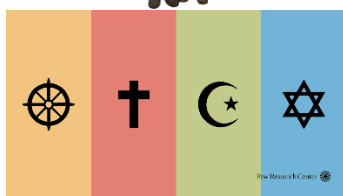
Because your skin is a different colour.
